



## PROVIDER OPTIONS FOR DEAF CLIENTS

Beacon Mental Health would like to make you aware of options for your treatment services. The Missouri Department of Mental Health has established two Specialized Outpatient Centers (one in Kansas City and one in St. Louis) to provide mental health services to consumers who are Deaf. The center in Kansas City is through ReDiscover and they have an ASL-fluent therapist on staff, as well as additional staff with specialized training to work with Deaf consumers. If you would like to transfer your therapy services to ReDiscover, we can certainly assist you with this. However, we want to assure you that you may continue to receive all of your services through Beacon Mental Health Services if that is what you want to do. We will make an interpreter available for you for any appointments you have.

If you decide that you would like to transfer your therapy services to ReDiscover's Specialized Outpatient Center, please contact Carrie Fraipont, the Deaf Services Advocate, at (816)877-0480 to assist you with that. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact the Deaf Services Advocate.

Telehealth options are available at the Beacon office to receive individual therapy with a clinician at a Specialized Outpatient Center who is a Deaf Services Specialist/therapist, if you choose, or you can receive these telehealth services from your home.

I understand that I can receive therapy services from a Specialized Outpatient Center but I can choose to have Beacon Mental Health provide my mental health services. I understand that I can change my mind and obtain services elsewhere at any time.
